The tour will allow you to appreciate several interesting sites in the city such as the old part, its deep-waters harbor, the steep streets that climb the Andean slopes, some of the typical houses that belonged to the first pioneering settlers of the region, the building of the old National Presidium of Ushuaia which was built between 1902 and 1920 The tour concludes with the visit to the World's End Museum, interesting due to its collection—of objects that belonged to the ancient aboriginal cultures that inhabited the region before the arrival of the white men: yamanas, selkhams and alacalufs; as well as objects related to the history of the island and its first white settlers. You will also have time to shop in the many unique craft stores

In the afternoon transfer to the airport to fly to Calafate to meet the other guests and start the land tour of the Argentine Patagonia
